Application Guidelines

Sections:

A) List all 4-H projects completed during the 4-H year. A 4-H Record Book must be submitted for at least two projects and after judging receive a score of 80 or higher on each.

B) List activities you participated in for 4-H. At least one activity must be a 4-H- sponsored activity that either is beyond the county level, or may lead to a level beyond county. Examples: County Events Day, Marine Ecology Event, 4-H State Dog Show, 4-H Livestock or Horse Judging, State 4-H Shooting Sports Contests, or County Horse Show. Note that Youth Fair and State Fair are *not* 4-H-sponsored events.

C) Include and describe leadership roles or positions that you have held this year in 4-H. It could be a club office, a county office, or leadership in an activity. Examples: club secretary, Youth Council member (this is a position of leadership, but not a club office), club song leader, helping younger members with a project, organizing an event or community service, committee chairperson, etc.

D) Complete the Community Service Record Sheet to list community service activities along with the number of hours served. Members must serve minimum of 15 hours to be eligible (subject to verification).

E) All signatures must be included. Club leader and parents should make comments about why the 4-H members should be considered for the award.

Tips:

- Each section must be complete on the application for eligibility.
- Writing must be neat and legible; typing is acceptable.
- Application should be completed by the 4-H member.
- Double-check that all signature lines have been signed.

Call the 4-H office if you need further clarification or have a question about a specific event.

All Green and White recipients will be recognized at the 4-H Awards and Recognition Banquet.
